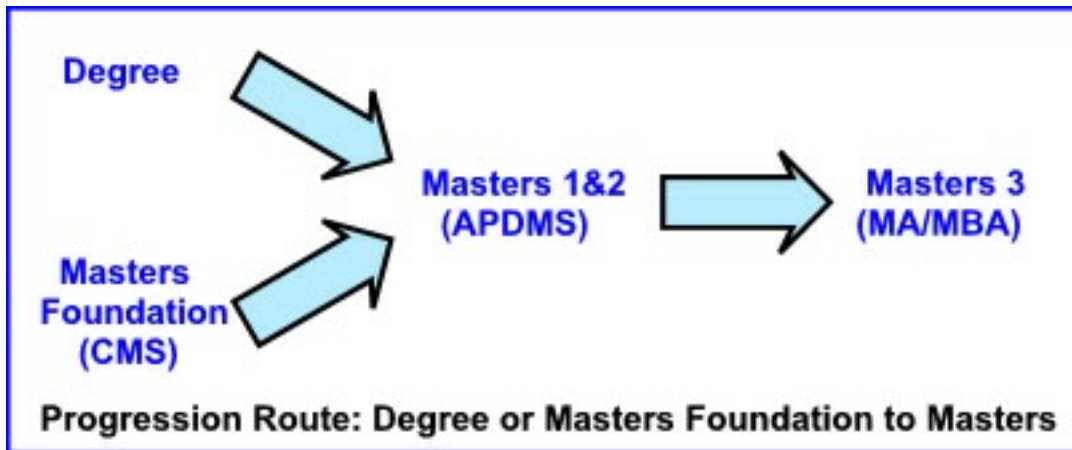

Management Qualifications and Professional Recognition

Cambridge Management College (CMC) is both an approved Management Centre and an e-learning Centre of the leading international awarding body, Edexcel. Through this awarding body and its own initiatives, CMC has links to over 20 universities at both undergraduate and graduate levels. CMC is accredited by the British Accreditation Council (BAC) for Independent further and higher education and is listed on the Department for Education and Skills (DfES) list of approved suppliers of education and training.

The Masters 1&2 may lead to the last phase of the MA/MBA at a UK university. The interim award of an APDMS is made on successful completion of this programme of 9 modules.



The Key Elements of the Study Programme Include:

- providing an understanding of the inter-relationships between different management functions
- analysing the relationships between organisations and their environment
- facilitating an in-depth investigation of management problems
- refining conceptual and analytical abilities of participants
- enabling students to complete a post-graduate (Level 7) qualification

The Programme of Study

The programme performs the role of integrating managerial functions and build upon the understanding of those disciplines gained by earlier study at Masters Foundation or first-degree level. It focuses upon the contemporary business issues which all managers must address in the increasingly-globalised business environment. The APDMS/Masters 1&2 is made up of the modules:

- Advanced Professional Development
- Managing Change
- Research methods
- Strategic Planning
- Strategic Implementation
- Strategic Marketing Management
- Principles of Financial Management and Techniques
- HR Planning and Development
- Management Project



The Programme of Study

The two parts (Part 1 and Part 2) of the programme are made up as follows:

Once you successfully complete Part 1, you will automatically gain the Edexcel Advanced Professional Diploma in Management Studies which is a Level 7, post-graduate qualification. Some of the Part 1 modules are further developed in Part 2 but you will be assessed only once in these particular modules.

How You May Study

While some students opt to study at home, by distance learning, others prefer the full-time course. Linked to the full-time course are special workshops which enable students to gain an additional professional qualification with the Chartered Management Institute.

Whichever way you choose, you will attain the internationally-recognised and accredited qualification - APDMS and, if you attend the workshops, an MCMI or FCMI. The full-time programme takes 14 months while the part-time programme's duration is flexible, taking about 20 months.

All students receive all the materials necessary to complete the course, including:

- ♦ induction, schedules of work
- ♦ independent learner guides, log books
- ♦ core textbooks, case studies, readers
- ♦ CD's MP3's and access to e-library

Professional Recognition

With the CMS and CMC's workshops, you will be eligible to apply to the Chartered Management Institute for Membership providing that your employment is appropriate. The CMI offers many facilities for its members in addition to the status which professional membership gives.

What it All Costs

The fee for the course includes all the course materials, assessments, access to e-library, etc. For details of course costs, please consult the CMC prospectus or web site.

Entry Requirements

As the language of tuition for the MBA is English, you will be required to be proficient in the use of the English Language and to be able to demonstrate this. Our colleagues in the English-Language department can help you to develop this competence if required.

Students likely to benefit more-readily from the programme may have one of the following:

- ♦ a Certificate in Management Studies
- ♦ CMC's Pre-Masters Course
- ♦ a first degree/professional qualification
- ♦ experience of working in management at an appropriate level

Students without formal qualifications but with relevant work experience may be considered for entry to this programme. Cambridge Management College shares the educational philosophy of Edexcel to widen student access to its courses. If you do not have any of the above qualifications, please contact the college registrar for further details.

Where You may Study

The flexibility of delivery of CMC's courses means that you are free to choose where you study. You may start off using the carefully structured Independent - Learning materials which will guide you step-by-step through the course material - backed up by the experienced team of tutors here in the UK and begin the journey to the qualification that you need. At some stage - when you feel that you wish to do so, you may apply to one of CMC's associated colleges and study further, either at home or in the UK. Whichever way you choose, you can be sure that CMC has worked out a progression route which will take you to the qualification which you desire.

Progression

While the Edexcel APDMS is a self-contained post-graduate qualification in its own right it also provides exemption from the CMI assessments for Membership and Fellowship of this institute, some students may wish to the next stage of their post-graduate studies for a Masters Degree at a university.
