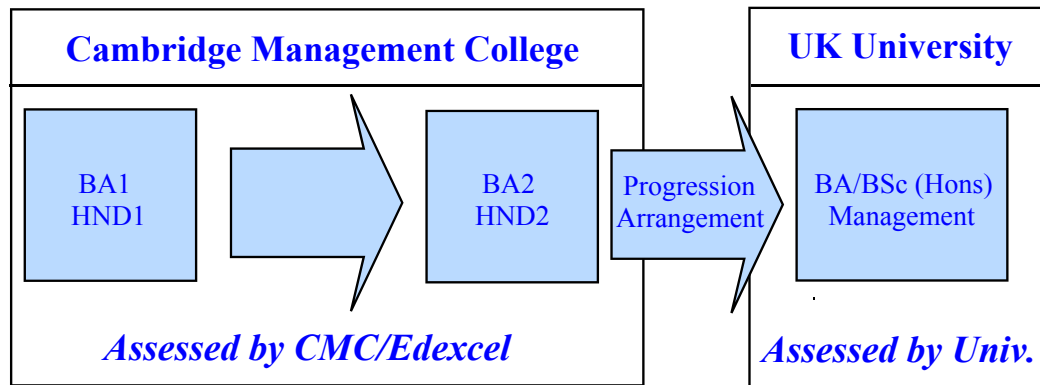

Management Qualifications and Professional Recognition

Cambridge Management College (CMC) is both an approved Management Centre and an e-learning Centre of the leading international awarding body, Edexcel.

This programme leads to the attainment of the first two parts (essentially the first two years) of a BA/BSc Degree in Business/Management. In addition to the degree, the student receives the award of Higher National Diploma which is accredited by the awarding body Edexcel. Following these awards, the student may go on to study for the final year of the degree at one of a number of UK universities, more details of which are provided overleaf.



The Key Elements of the Study Programme Include:

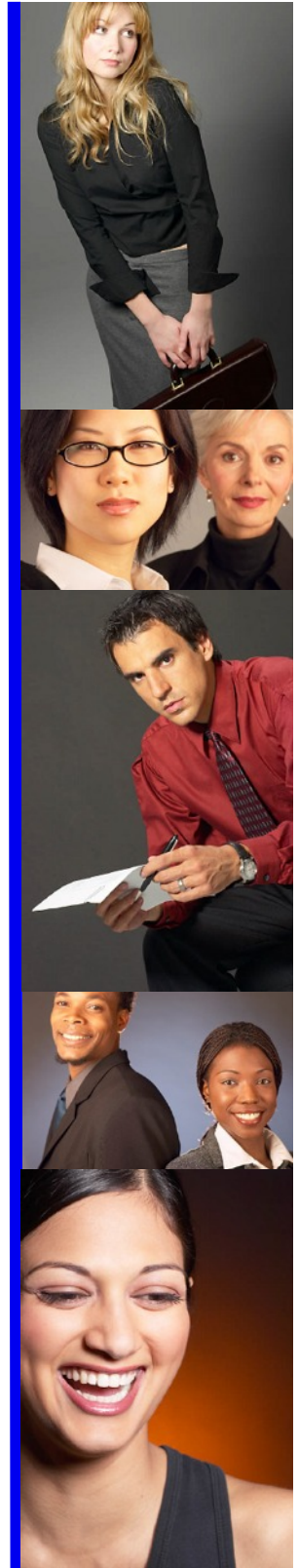
- Specialist vocational programmes
- Linked to the requirements of employers and professional bodies

- Enables students to progress to professional qualifications
- Enables students to complete a degree via third year entry

The Programme of Study

This is a two-year programme and, during this period, students complete 16 modules including a project. Although this results in a nominal eight modules per year, the project is often started at the beginning of the study period and is run as a continuous theme throughout the programme. The subjects covered range from Personal Development through to the External Business Environment and cover the key areas of operations, marketing and finance.

The programme is designed to cover the learning outcomes of the Edexcel HND award but is supplemented with material which provides a thorough cognitive base for future study at the university of choice. As the course is designed to lead onto a variety of different university programmes, great care is taken to ensure that a solid understanding of the principles of business and management is gained by students, enabling them to integrate this knowledge of their future chosen course. Not only does this provide for a wide range of institutions for future study but it also allows for a wide range of specialisations to be considered at these institutions.

Great care is taken to ensure that all subject taught, while being academically rigorous, are also covered in a way which relates to current practice and are immediately applicable in the workplace.



How and Where You May Study

The course is full time (minimum of 16 hours per week plus personal study time) and is provided by our own unique blended learning programme. With this programme, you will be able to take advantage of the powerful materials developed by our expert team while studying for the CMI component of our course by workshops delivered by a college of your choice at home.

Entry Requirements

As the language of tuition for the programme is English, you will be required to be proficient in the use of the English Language. If the language requirement proves to be an impediment to your enrolment, please contact us and we can put you in touch with a co-operating college which provides English-language tuition geared to the needs of business/management students.

You will also be required to have studied successfully:

- GCE 'A' Level
- GCSE's
- or GCE 'O' Level with relevant work experience
- or the CMC Certificate in Management
- or a BTEC National
- or a Level 3 National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) or a GNVQ/Vocational A Level
- or a foundation programme validated by Edexcel or by Cambridge Management College (CMC) or relevant work experience without formal qualifications can be considered for entry to this qualification.

Cambridge Management College has carefully-designed routes which will lead you on to the qualification that you wish from where you are and our qualified staff will assist you in making the decisions along the way.

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Progression to a Degree

If you wish to carry on studying once you have completed your studies with CMC, you may take advantage of one of the progression agreements which have been agreed with UK Universities. These give final year entry to their degrees/honours degrees to holders of the CMC/Edexcel HND. Other institutions give 'advanced standing' for HND holders. Please check with the relevant university for further details. Among the UK universities offering such progression are:

Brunel (West London), Central Lancashire, Coventry, De Montfort (Leicester), East Anglia, Essex, Gloucestershire, Greenwich, Liverpool, Northumbria, Nottingham Trent, Reading, Sheffield Hallam, Southampton, Sussex, Thames Valley, University of Wales - Cardiff Institute and Westminster.

Progression to Masters Degree

When you complete this programme and your final year of the degree, you may apply to do a masters degree. Alternatively, on completion of this two-year programme, you may elect to study on CMC's Foundation Masters/Certificate in Management Studies Programme and then proceed onto the CMC Masters 1&2/APDMS. This qualification, the Advanced Professional Diploma in Management Studies is a Level 7 (post-graduate) qualification which will provide access to the later stages of a Masters Degree

Where you may study

The flexibility of delivery of CMC's courses means that you are free to choose where you study. You may start off using the carefully structured Independent - Learning materials which will guide you step-by-step through the course material - backed up by the experienced team of tutors here in the UK and begin the journey to the qualification that you need. At some stage - when you feel that you wish to do so, you may apply to one of CMC's associated colleges and study further, either at home or in the UK. Whichever way you choose, you can be sure that CMC has worked out a progression route which will take you to the qualification that you desire.
